## Announcement / Invitation

## 1. General

The Bavarian Open Competition is conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations \& Technical Rules Single \& PairSkating and Ice Dance 2022 and the relevant ISU Communications and this Announcement.

The Bavarian Open Competition is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify concerning eligibility according to ISU Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in ISU Rule 108, paragraph 3 and they meet the participation, citizenship, and residency requirements in ISU Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

Following ISU Rule 109 and ISU Communication 2030 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, have to be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

## Feedback Sessions supported by ISU Development Program

As a project of the ISU Development Program, Advanced Novice and Junior skaters of all disciplines are welcome to sign up for an individual post-competition feedback session and video analysis by ISU Officials. The registered participants will be provided with a USB stick after the discussion for further self-evaluation of the comments made. The presence of their coaches is appreciated. Participation is free of charge. Special entry forms are provided under Appendix A. A special schedule will be established and published.

The main arena and the practice rink are side by side in the same building with the ice surface of $60 \mathrm{~m} \times 30 \mathrm{~m}$, heated, air-conditioned and closed.

Date: 30 January - 04 February 2024
Entries: Members of the International Skating Union and their respective Member Clubs are invited to participate in the competition.
Competitors are to be entered by their respective Member Federation. All entries to the Bavarian Open 2024 must be done through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) by the entry deadline December 17 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ 2023, 20:00 (local time Oberstdorf/Germany).
Entries into Pair categories are not limited.

> Each ISU Member may nominate up to three (3) individual skaters/lce Dance couples except for the Advanced Novice category in Ice Dance and Intermediate Novice category in Ice Dance, in which up to four (4) couples would be accepted. The host member (Deutsche Eislauf-Union e.V.) may exceed this limit. Members are welcome to add names of substitute skaters. Due to the total number of entries in each category, the OC will decide, if and how many substitute skaters/couples can be accepted. The OC reserves the right to limit the number of entries per category. If the OC has to limit the number of entries, priority will be given to those countries that have entered a Judge. Officials: Members are kindly requested to nominate one International/ISU Judge and/or International/ISU TS/TC Official for Figure Skating and/or Ice Dance. Judges or TS/TC Officials qualified for both
disciplines are very welcome. The nomination of a substitute is appreciated, but the Organizer reserves the right to reduce the number of Judges/Technical Officials in case of too many nominations. The composition of the panels will be finalised after the Entry deadline. It will be published to the participating members in time. The organizer will cover accommodation for accepted Judges/Technical Officials. Meals are provided for them at the ice rink during the days of competition.

Time-Schedule: The competition is planned to start on January 30th, 2024 and will be finished on Sunday, February 04th, 2024. Due to the number of Advanced Novice entries the competition may start already in the afternoon of January 30th, 2024. A detailed Time Schedule is sent to all participating Members soon after the Entry deadline.

Accommodation: The organizer will care about the hotel arrangements for accepted Judges and Technical Officials only.

and 513. For Novice categories it might be done on the same day as the first segment.
There will be no intermediate Draws. The starting order for FS/FD is the reverse order of the result of SP/RD/PD.

Awards: The first three placed Skaters/Couples in each discipline are awarded trophies. Small memory gifts will be provided for all participants. A special Award Ceremony Schedule will be published with the Official Time Schedule.

Liability: In accordance with ISU Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Bavarian Open Figure Skating and Ice Dance 2024, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials, and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.
The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection by Competitors, Officials, or other participating persons.

Live Stream/TV: Live Stream of the Competition is provided. By entering the competition, each person agrees on recordings and/or transmissions (e.g. via the internet, TV) of his/her/their performance, appearance, picture, voice, or other personal characteristics displayed in connection with the event, towards an unrestricted audience and without temporal or geographical limits.
